



### SAYOKAN UNIFORM STANDARD

Sayokan uniforms are called ÇAPAN. Anchors that do not comply with the standards are not accepted in the championships. Sayokan Capans are historical clothing and have been preserved for thousands of years.

In the Sayokan championships, the "Western Alp" is the white corner. The "Eastern Alp" is the blue corner. The Western Alp wears a white belt around his/her waist, and the Eastern Alp wears a blue belt around his waist. The trousers of these uniforms are white.

#### ALAGAN ÇAPAN



The Anchors above are used by athletes in the Seniors (Konuralp Boyu) and Adults (Baturalp) categories. In other words, athletes in the categories of 18 years and above use it. This çapan is called ALAGAN ÇAPAN.

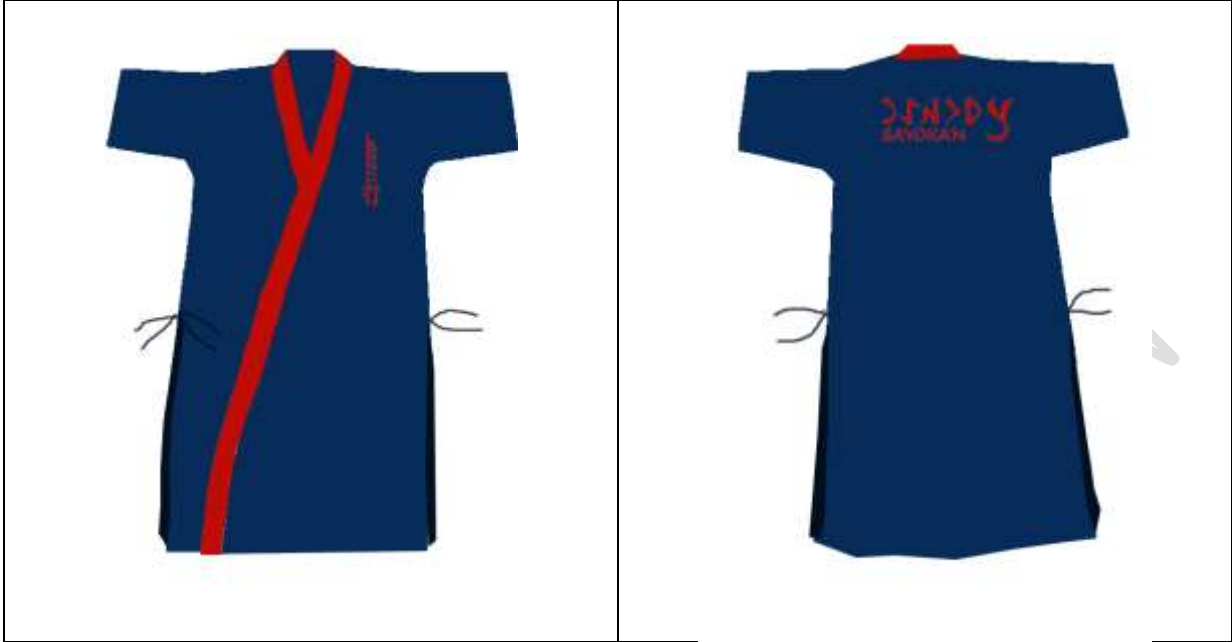

This Çapan is used by people who are at the 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, and 10th black belt level. Sayokan is a military system and each rank has a uniform. This is the reason for such uniform diversity. When you look at it, everyone's title can be understood by his/her title uniform, and the belt around their waist.

**REFEREE ÇAPAN**



Referee Çapan. In Sayokan, the referee is called SINAYÇI. Referees use this uniform in all competitions.
